Banking Procedural Changes

To earn more interest on CBW funds, the Board moved \$500,000 of reserve funds out of a non-interest bearing account into a Fidelity US Government Securities brokerage account.

The Board plans to deposit future reserve funds into the Fidelity account and move excess "Insurance Fund" and "Insurance Deductible Fund" money to the account. While these funds will be in the same account, CBW books will list separate assets for the accounts on its Balance Sheet.



Infrastructure Update

Reverse Osmosis Plant

A working group has been formed to pursue the replacement of CBW's 50-year-old RO plant. A big thank you to Bill Bacon for discovering a grant under an EPA Community Clean Water program administered by the VI DPNR. To apply for the grant, CBW must submit an engineer's "Plan and Design" to VI DPNR. The agency performs an environmental impact study. DPNR submits our application and its environmental impact study to the EPA for review. The process takes several months to complete. CBW Board is currently soliciting engineer proposals.

Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) Upgrade

CBW is receiving bids for the construction of additional tanks and securing permits to start construction. Once all bids are in, the Board will present owners with a summary of the project and bids.

Per CBW Bylaws, expenditures over \$100,000 must be approved by $\frac{2}{3}$ majority of owners to proceed. Total expenditures for this project are expected to exceed \$100,000.
